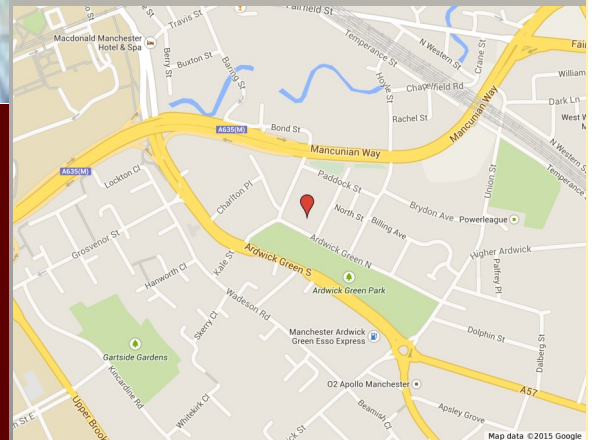
A valuable opportunity to gain insight into this important area of theory and practice with one of the foremost international practitioners.
